More details about the JCS Chapter of 100 WWC

The school administration selects a variety of projects which are in need of funding outside the school general budget. The projects are chosen based on the educational needs of students and the long-term strategic plan of the school.

Members of 100 WWC, choose projects from the list that they would like 100 WWC to fund. Members may gather additional information about those projects in anticipation of the opportunity to make a presentation.

Members, who would like to be presenters, will place their name in a drawing at the beginning of each meeting. 3 names will be drawn. If your name is drawn you will be given 5 minutes to present the project you would most like to see funded.

At the conclusion of the 3 presentations each member will cast their vote for the project they would like to see funded. The winning project will be chosen by the majority vote.

Members make a commitment to contribute \$100, even if they don't care for the "winning" project. The school acknowledges all contributions with a giving receipt for tax purposes.

Each member commits to donating \$100 per meeting (\$400 per year). If you are unable to attend - give your check to a member to deliver on your behalf or use Donate Online on the JCS website.

Checks are made payable to JCS and are designated for the specific JCS project selected by majority vote of the members at each meeting.
