

Tuition Reduction Incentive Program (TRIP) Policies

TRIP is offered through Jackson Christian School by a volunteer committee. Its purpose is to allow families the opportunity to earn money that can reduce tuition and fees for participating families. Families can also invite friends and relatives to participate and direct their TRIP savings toward their tuition and fees. There are two opportunities for you to take advantage of TRIP.

ONLINE ORDERING Through Shopwithscrip.Com

The first option is ordering your trip cards online at Shop With Scrip.com. Their website is full of helpful information to get you started on the path to earning money towards your tuition account. You'll create an account at ShopWithScrip.com and once your account is activated, you will be able to order gift cards, reload gift cards, or order ScriptNow certificates. To active your account, you will need the JCS enrollment code, which is **EC82A78F1945**.

PrestoPay on Shop With Scrip

Prestopay is an electronic payment system on Shop With Scrip. When you pay for your order with PrestoPay, your gift cards will be delivered to the school for pick up each Friday. You can also choose ScripNow or reloadable cards which are delivered electronically at the time you place an order.

ORDERING AT SCHOOL

The second option for participating in TRIP is to place your order and pay for gift cards at the school. Drop boxes are located on each campus near the office. TRIP volunteers are also on hand each Monday morning from 7:45-8:20 on both campuses. All orders delivered to the school must be received no later than 8:20 AM. (Later orders will be held until the following week.) Orders must be accompanied by a money order or personal check made out to JCS TRIP. (No Cash is accepted)

Orders placed on Monday are available for pick up on the sampus where the order was placed on Friday of the same week between 7:45 - 8:20 AM. Orders not picked up will be locked up in the school safe. Orders must be verified and signed for at the time of pick up.

NSF Policy

Upon receiving two Non-Sufficient Fund (NSF) checks, participation will be terminated for that participant. Any NSF charges will be passed on to the participating family.

OTHER HELPFUL INFORMATION

~Family and friends may help you reduce tuition by participating in TRIP and directing their savings to your tuition account on the registration form. Participants may also choose to direct their savings to one or more of the following accounts: Tuition (current or future), another family's tuition, JCS technology fund, or JCS financial aid fund.

~TRIP savings will be credited to your account once annually, one month prior to re-enrollment (usually February). TRIP funds can only be used for Jackson Christian School Tuition and Fees.

~The TRIP earnings from each order are reflected on the front of the envelope that contains your gift cards.

~Funds accumulated by participants who do not re-enroll or complete a school year may be transferred to another participant's account, at your direction. Undesignated funds from families who are no longer enrolled are credited to the TRIP general account. Funds left in the general account will be given annually to a chosen JCS need.

~ Order forms are updated regularly due to changes in participating merchants or discount percentages. If you order infrequently, please verify that you are using the most current order form. Each participating merchant chooses the percentage of savings they offer. Percentages may change without prior notice.

~ The TRIP program retains one percent of each order to cover expenses such as shipping, paper, mailings, etc.

~ TRIP will run weekly during the school year, except for scheduled school vacations. In case of a Monday snow day, orders are placed at the same time on Tuesday. If school does not resume by Tuesday, there will be no order that week and the normal schedule will resume the following week.

Only you can make this program successful for your family. By participating, you can benefit from saving on purchases that you would normally make. Our hope is that each one of us will become careful stewards of all God has given us -perhaps the TRIP program can be a part of that plan.
